



# Umbraco usync








## Definition



Umbraco package database and file syncing tool for transferring between computer/servers/environments





## Installation




## **NuGet Package**

• Run the command PM> Install-Package uSync (-Version \*)

#### **Our Umbraco**

- Download package from https://our.umbraco.org/projects/developer-tools/usync/
- Install via the package installer inside Umbraco










- Dashboard => located in the Developer section
- Export in uSync/data => xml format

#### **Umbraco 8**

- Dashboard => located in the Settings section
- Export in usync/v8 => json format




#### **Export**

- Once uSync is running it will generate xml (json for Umbraco 8) files of all document types, data types, macros... made in the backoffice and will place them in the uSync/data folder.
- For Umbraco 7 it follows the folder structure from the backoffice

#### **Import**

 Once uSync import is running it will import the xml (json for Umbraco 8) files into the database








For setting up the uSync package use the following files uSyncBackOffice.config uSyncCore.config placed in Config folder in the project







• content and media items synchronization

#### uSync.Snapshots

 Allows you to take moment in time snapshots of changes you have made

#### uSync.Core

• The core uSync engine & API - allowing you to write your own syncing routines

### uSync.HealthChecks (NuGet)

• Health checks on the state of your uSync folder and files

#### uSync.Chauffeur (NuGet)

• uSync through the command line
